

Birding With The Trust!

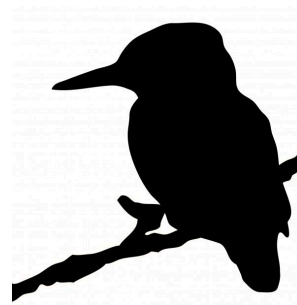


Please join our volunteer Bird Team to see some of the many species of birds that Vieques has to offer!

All Bird Walks start on the Malecon in front of The Vieques Conservation and Historical Trust in Esperanza at 7:30 a.m. Just look for the birders!

If possible, please bring binoculars and wear sturdy shoes. Bird Walks are “local” and last approximately two to two and a half hours. Unfortunately, we are unable to provide transportation; carpooling is encouraged.
